In 2015 Atlas was awarded the Gail Miller Recognition for Excellence in Safety Gold Ranking by the National Frame Builders Association. The NFBA invites their entire membership to submit copies of their safety programs, in detail, and the programs are then graded by the NFBA Safety Committee and legal counsel. In addition to the standard questions regarding topics such as Lock Out/Tag Out procedures, fall protection and other standard OSHA regulations, the NFBA inquired about such things as how Atlas involves employees in safety, what our enforcement program is, what training we provide, how we train and how we hold employees accountable. Our program was evaluated anonymously and feedback was given to us by the grading committee.

Employee safety at Atlas is continually improving and evolving. Atlas employees have made some very good progress towards making Atlas safer work environment. Safety is a major focus for Atlas and our *Work S.M.A.R.T.* program has allowed us to continue to improve safety through increased involvement of the entire Atlas organization.
